



2-Bedroom Villa, Seminyak

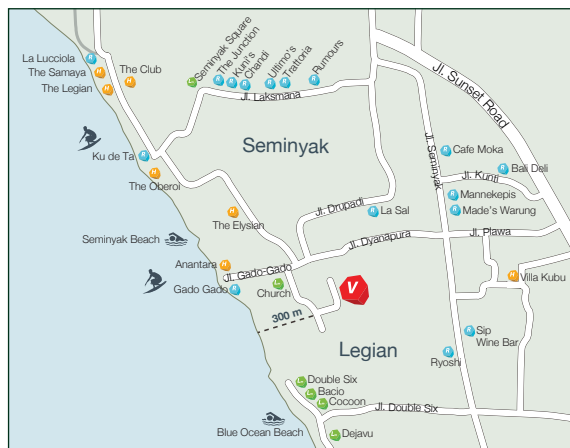

Location

Sweeping Seminyak beach is renowned for its world-class surf breaks and panoramic coastline views.

Things to do

- Shop till you drop! In Seminyak and neighbouring Kerobokan you can rummage for treasures through cluttered little stores and dark junkshops crammed to the ceiling with curios and 'made-to-order' antiques, derive inspiration from classy homeware shops, or wander through huge furniture warehouses.
- It's possible to walk the sands of Seminyak's beach all the way to Kuta in the south, or north to Canggu.
- With its warm seas, almost year-round season, relatively uncrowded beach and reef breaks and suitability for all levels of experience, Bali surfing is world renowned.
- Covering 3.8 hectares of tropical parkland in Kuta, Waterbom Bali has 16 water slides (including The Climax with its 360 degree loop) to entertain the young and the young at heart. A great family day out, but go early to beat the crowds.
- Cycling is a great way to explore the scenic rice-field landscape and rural villages and get under the skin of the 'real' Bali and there are four bicycles available for guest use at Lataliana.
